## The False Flag Fixer Difference

### It's AI detecting AI.

Not to be confused with synonym checkers, paraphraser, or rewriters. Those tools swap words randomly. They don't know which words trigger AI detectors. They don't know why "furthermore" is risky. They don't read sentences. They just swap.

### We reverse-engineered Turnitin.

We know exactly what triggers false flags. We explain why. We show the risk score. Then we let students fix it — their way.

We don't rewrite. We don't paraphrase. We don't change your voice. We predict what Turnitin will flag. Before you submit.

### Example from a real student scan:


Flagged phrase: "detrimental impact"

Why it's risky: "Detrimental impact" is corporate jargon. Real students say 'harms students' or 'hurts them.' This pairing feels like a thesaurus lookup.

Alternatives offered: harmful effect, negative outcome, problem, issue, consequence, challenge, harm, effect

Score impact: 78% → 25% (53 point drop). Student's choice. Student's voice. Fixed.

### The visual story:



**Screenshot 1** (Left - Flagged phrase + explanation): "We identify risky phrases and explain exactly why they trigger AI detectors."

**Screenshot 2** (Right - Alternatives + one-click swap): "Student controls the fix. Pick which alternative fits your voice. Apply instantly."

**False Flag Fixer predicts what Turnitin will flag and lets you decide how to fix it. Better safe than sus. ▶**
